## The Professor K. Patricia Cross Collaborative Scholarship Award

## Call for Proposals – Due Mon., April 2, 2018

We invite proposals from collaborative teams of students in the Graduate School of Education at the University of California, Berkeley who show interest in and promise as creative future leaders in teaching and learning for a scholarship named in honor of Professor Emerita Pat Cross for her lifelong commitment to teaching and learning.

Joint proposals will be considered from teams of at least three and no more than five students for innovative research that improves classroom practice and strengthens teaching and learning. Each member of the team will receive an equal proportion of the total of available funds. The recipients of the Professor K. Patricia Cross Collaborative Scholarship Award will be selected by faculty of the Graduate School of Education based on the quality of their research proposal, along with a demonstrated commitment to teaching and learning; a record of academic excellence; and interest in pursuit of research that improves classroom practice and the development of collaboration amongst scholars and students. Awards may be used to collect pilot data for a larger project, or preliminary work for a dissertation.

The Professor K. Patricia Cross Collaborative Scholarship for the 2018 Spring Semester will be \$10,200 total. To be considered for this award, please submit a joint proposal of 2 - 3 pages and include a statement from each team member about their background, interests and desired career trajectory, a CV and a letter of reference from an advisor or faculty member.

## **SELECTION**

Prospective recipients will be identified through a joint proposal competition and selected by the Dean and the Fellowship Committee of the Graduate School of Education. Award notifications will be made by April 20, 2018.

## **REPORTING**

Award recipients will provide a brief 1-2 page report by September 1, 2018 describing the progress of the collaborative project. A brief final report will be required at the end of the project.
